



Requirements for Ambulance Preceptorship

To participate in the ambulance preceptorship, you must have proof of:

- At least 19 years of age, prior the preceptorship experience
- Successful completion of Term – 1 and Term – 2
- Successful completion of a Paramedic Physical Abilities Test. (PPAT)
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector
- Immunization or Proof of Immunity to:
 - MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
 - Pertussis
 - Tetanus
 - Diphtheria
 - Hepatitis B
 - Varicella
- Proof of a negative result on a Two-step TB Test
- Signed Student Confidentiality Agreement with applicable stakeholder
- Signed Student Waiver & Release of applicable stakeholder
- N95 Mask Fit Test completed
- Class 4 Driver's Licence & CEVO4 Training
 - If the student wishes to drive during their preceptorship experience
- Tuition Fees Paid

Requirements for Clinical Practicum

To participate in the clinical practicum, you must have proof of:

- Successful completion of Term – 1 and Term – 2
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector
- Immunization or Proof of Immunity to:
 - MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
 - Pertussis
 - Tetanus
 - Diphtheria
 - Hepatitis B
 - Varicella
- Proof of a negative result on a Two-step TB Test
- Completion of all mandatory e-learning modules
- Review and acknowledgement of all relevant stakeholder policies
- Signed Education Placement Agreement with applicable stakeholder
- N95 Mask Fit Test completed
